Arrival at Capovalle at 9.00 a.m. It is possible to park next to the museum

Walk from Capovalle to Monte Stino

It is possible to reach monte Stino following the directions "Monte Stino appostamenti bellici".

The departure is contrada Zumie, and after 4,5 km walking it is possible to reach the church "alpini".

Following the path it is possible to reach the tunnels and the trench.

Visit war museum and the parish church

Take your car and visit Sanctuary Madonna Rio Secco

Following the way to Idro, at the intersection Treviso Bresciano it is possible to park the car.

Continuing walking (20 minutes) on the way to Treviso Bresciano, it is possible to reach the sanctuary.

The war museum Il museo dei reperti bellici

Capovalle was on the border Italy-Austria during the First World War.

During the Second World War Capovalle was besieged by germans.

It was a strategical place in the history of recent Wars.

On the Monte Stino is possible to visit the military tunnel and the trench.

In the 1990s Mr Giuseppe Lombardi decide to create a museum dedicated to war at Monte Stino.

Recently the municipality decide to move the museum from the mountain to a building in the village.

The new museum is close to the town hall and the parish church.

At the small museum you can find helmet, weapons, munitions, uniforms, photos and medals.
